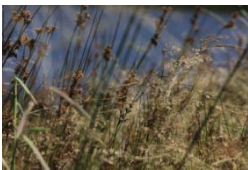

Prelude for a Static Home, 2013

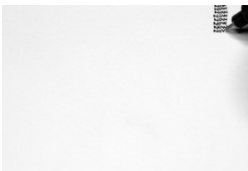
